## MRS PATRICIA GILBERT

Secretary, 1960 - 1989

Members who knew the Society's previous Secretary, Mrs Gilbert, will be greatly saddened to learn of her death on 28 December 1999 at the age of 70 after a few months' illness. Her death is reported in the Annual Report accompanying this mailing and a full tribute will be published in the *Journal of Roman Studies* and *Britannia* this coming November.

The Council of the Society proposes to establish a fund in Mrs Gilbert's memory to buy books for the Library in the areas covered by *Britannia*, which was founded in her time as Secretary. She did much not only to promote the success of the Society's second journal, but also to ensure that the Library's needs were properly considered. Since *Britannia* is sub-titled 'a journal of Romano-British and kindred studies', purchases may include, for example, books on Roman Gaul and Germany.

Contributions to the fund may be sent to the Secretary at the Society's address. Cheques should be made payable to the 'Joint Library Account'.

*Athenaeus and his World* is the first sustained attempt to understand and explore the work of Athenaeus as a whole, and in its own right.
